OVERVIEW: At Family Promise of Spokane, we create and iterate technology and tools to end family homelessness. We are looking for a friendly, organized, and self-directed candidate to fill the Research and Development/IT Intern position. A successful R&D Intern will be able to learn, manage and maintain IT technologies such as electronics, software, and data for Family Promise of Spokane (FPS), and use them to intentionally Innovate the next generation of Homeless Service programs in our region.

INTERNSHIP AREAS AND OPPORTUNITIES

This internship has the opportunity to provide growth, and experience in the following:

- Utilizing data to drive the development of cutting edge service programs that help families achieve housing stability
- User-centered program design, both software and service programs
- Experience with Homeless Management Information Systems (HMIS), their usage, history, structure and role in national homeless services
- Custom Shelter Management/Case Management software development and maintenance
- Research into local and national factors of homelessness, and solutions
- Data analysis on large datasets generated by internal and external CRM systems
- Development and utilization of predictive models to identify and rapidly solve housing instability
- Data correction and processing, using national standards, for error correction, and reporting
- Data base/lake/warehouse utilization and management
- Information and data dashboard creation and management
- Office Environment IT infrastructure installation, deployment and maintenance

POSITION DUTIES

The R&D/IT Intern will serve as an extension of the Research and Development department.

- Research and development (70%)
 - Assist Director of R&D with data and systems (software and service) research
 - Run various reports for R&D team to facilitate requirements for grant reporting and applications
 - Work with Director of R&D and R&D team with various software/technology/service pilot programs
 - Prepare and utilize FPS data for reporting and dashboard creation
 - Periodically analyze FPS data with a specific focus on recognizing trends to facilitate the creation and iteration of service programs

 Generation and conversion of data from and into CSV/XLSX/ODT and other formats

• IT and infrastructure management (30%)

- Assist with troubleshooting, updating and maintaining internal software systems, including Windows, Mac and Linux operating systems
- Assist with installation and maintenance of modems, switches, DVRs, cameras, computers, laptops, etc. as needed by the organization
